Grain and Feedstuffs Market Trend

Compared to last period: Trade active on good demand for organic feed corn. Trade light on moderate to good demand for organic feed soybeans. Trade activity and demand moderate on organic feed wheat. Organic feed corn sold 1 cents lower delivered elevator with the bulk of activity on forward contracts delivering Q2 2025 through Q3 2026. Organic feed soybeans sold 1.03 lower delivered elevator with forward contracts delivering Q2 2025 through Q3 2026. Organic feed soybeans sold 1.03 lower delivered elevator with forward contracts delivering Q2 2025 through Q1 2026. Organic feed wheat sold 52 cents higher delivered elevator with forward contracts delivering Q3 2025 through Q1 2026. Organic food wheat contracts comprised of sub-10% protein wheat. Trade inactive on all other organic grains. The next available report will be Wednesday, July 23, 2025.

Current Midwest Drought Summary (July 1, 2025)

Heavy rain fell this week across portions of the Midwest, including central and south-central and northern Missouri, portions of Iowa, southern Minnesota, central and northern Wisconsin, the western Michigan Upper Peninsula, and portions of southern Indiana and Ohio. Warmer-than-normal temperatures covered most of the region, especially Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, southern Michigan and Kentucky, where temperatures ranging from 4-10 degrees above normal were common. Temperatures 1-4 degrees warmer than normal were more common in Iowa, Missouri and southern Wisconsin, while a small area of cooler-than-normal weather occurred in central Minnesota, where temperatures were mostly 1-4 degrees below normal. A mix of improvements and degradations to ongoing areas of drought and abnormal dryness occurred in Illinois, northwest Indiana and Minnesota. In these areas, soil moisture and precipitation deficits and surpluses continued to shift after recent heavy rain or lack thereof. Improvements to ongoing drought or abnormal dryness occurred in northern Missouri, lowa, Wisconsin and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, where heavy recent rainfall lessened precipitation deficits and improved soil moisture.
