PATCH # 012

DOCUMENT: Fresh Electronic Inspection Reporting/Resource System (FEIRS) electronic programs revision.

REMARKS: Detailed Notesheets for Canadian Import and U.S. Export Inspections Performed on a FV-E205 and FV-E207.

PATCH # 010 of the General Market Manual, July 2015 stated that for Canadian import and U.S. export inspections for fresh product “lots not previously inspected or where the timeframe for the reference certificate has expired, detailed notesheets are required.” Since the FEIRS FV-E205 Certificate of Inspection for Canadian Destinations and FV-E207 Export Form Certificate for Non-Canadian Destinations are not configured with a FEIRS notesheet, inspectors must utilize one of the two options below in order to keep detailed notesheets when utilizing FEIRS to complete these inspections:

- Perform the full inspection on a FV/SC-300N paper notesheet to record the details of the inspection, then complete a FEIRS FV-E205 or FV-E207 utilizing the detailed sampling results from the FV/SC-300N. The FV/SC-300N will be kept on file with the corresponding FV/SC-237 Application for Inspection. Fee for the inspection will be listed on the FV-E205 or FV-E207 issued; or
- Perform the full inspection utilizing the FEIRS FV-E300:
 - The same Carrier/Lot ID information (PO number, trailer license number, bill of lading number, etc.) listed on the FV/SC-237 requesting the Canadian import or U.S. export inspection will be used.
 - The fee for the inspection will be listed on the FV-E300 with a remark cross-referencing it with the FV-E205 or FV-E207 issued.
 - Conversely, list the completed FV-E300 certificate number on the FV-E205 or FV-E207 under the “Cert/Worksheet Num” block (see below) and “NO CHARGE” under estimated fee with a remark cross-referencing the estimated fee that was charged on the FV-E300.

This PATCH represents official guidance. This PATCH is scheduled to be incorporated into the document listed above. After incorporation into the document listed above this PATCH will become obsolete. USDA is an equal opportunity provider, employer, and lender.
